This MIP project is open to full-time undergraduate Texas A&M students at Junior or Senior class levels in Hispanic Studies with intermediate or advanced conversational and reading proficiency in Spanish. Students must be in good academic standing with a minimum grade point average of 2.5/4.0.

### Program Dates

The Hispanic Studies Spring 2010 internship is 15 weeks onsite in Mexico City, beginning January 25th through May 7th, with some possibility of negotiating a shorter 10-week experience. During the week of the Spring semester classes, January 18 - 22, 2010, you will be trained in scanning protocols in the Cushing Library on the Texas A&M campus before you begin your internship in Mexico City.
