Texas A&M University Mexico Internship Program Summer 2010

The Mexico Internship Program (MIP) offers a unique opportunity to participate in an internship program to gain valuable work experience and explore a particular field from the viewpoint of the local Mexican culture. This MIP program is open to full-time undergraduate Texas A&M students at Junior or Senior class levels with the appropriate skills, experience and intermediate or advanced conversational and reading proficiency in Spanish. Students must be in good academic standing with a minimum grade point average of 2.5/4.0. Positions may require background investigation and security requirements.

This is a competitive internship program. The final selection for the MIP program is based upon a successful interview and acceptance by the employing organization. Depending upon the intern site, there is some possibility of extending your experience beyond the 10-week period; please indicate your interest on your application. You will be notified of your acceptance into the MIP program by March 15, 2010.
